

## EARLY YEARS QUALITY STANDARDS

The Early Years Quality Standards (EYQS) provides thought provoking challenge, brings fresh perspectives and promotes continuous quality improvement.

The EYQS includes tailored support and a thorough audit of provision. Participants will be assigned an HFL Early Years adviser as a mentor; who will support and guide them through the process.

To join the next cohort starting in September 2023 and attend our free EYQS online briefing on Thursday 14th September, 3.45pm – 4.45pm please email eyquality@hfleducation.org The EYQS has three levels of award and uses evidence based tools to support thorough self-evaluation.

The process takes up to one academic year to complete, depending on the level of award chosen.



## Autumn Term – BRONZE AWARD

A gateway visit from an adviser and self-evaluation using EYFS statutory framework.



## Autumn to Spring Term – SILVER AWARD

Includes a focussed visit using the Early Childhood Environment Rating Scale (ECERS).

The EYQS provided the opportunity to highlight what worked well using the ECERS scale, identifying and acknowledging how we work as a special school.
