

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Bespoke packages of support

2-day* bespoke subject package

Cost: £1,400

*Time often booked as 4 x half day visits.

Visits/focuses could include:

- Supporting subject leaders with understanding the role, what to focus on and actions to prioritise.
- Exploring and refining current curriculum mapping for a subject jointly with the subject leader.
- Support and coaching for subject leader/s including joint monitoring and evaluation activities to identify next steps.
- Staff CPD/INSET e.g. focused on effective science subject leadership and/or on assessment of learning.
- Co-developing and co-delivering subject focused staff CPD alongside the subject leader.

All visits can be followed up with a written report which will identify strengths, areas to consider or for development and clear agreed actions.
