Effective Evaluation of Early Years Provision

Our Effective Evaluation of Early Years Provision (EEEYP) package provides settings with a comprehensive external evaluation of their practice and provision.

The EEEYP can be useful to prepare settings for other external professionals visits to the setting.


During the visit, consultants will carry out observations with leaders and hold interviews with senior leaders, key staff and parents (agreed prior to the visit).

Following the evaluation, a detailed written report is provided that identifies key priorities and recommendations to support improvement of the quality of provision for children.

Early Years Quality Standards

The Early Years Quality Standards (EYQS) enables settings to take part in a process of self-evaluation and reflective practice. The EYQS has three levels of award and evidence based tools to support thorough self-evaluation. The process takes up to one academic year to complete, depending on the level of award chosen.
