IS THERE ACCOMMODATION AVAILABLE AT HINXTON HALL?

Yes, there is accommodation available for those wishing to stay on site. All accommodation

is managed directly via the following

website: www.hinxtonhall.org/accommodation/#how-to-book.

In order to book a room, please enter code **PHTC2025**, followed by entering the date/s you wish to have accommodation for and click search. To select your room, please click the see rates button within your chosen room type and increase the number of rooms accordingly.

Please note that rooms are held until 24th September. After this date, any available rooms will be removed from the HFL Education allocation and are subject to price increases at the venue's discretion.

The cost of accommodation on site is as follows:

- Bed & Breakfast, single occupancy £131 per night
- Standard rate, including breakfast (sleeping two people) £167 per night

In total, the following number of rooms are being held:

8th October - 48 bedrooms

9th October - 95 bedrooms (this is the maximum number of rooms available to book on site)
