Achieving Inspection Readiness (AIR) Visits

Our Achieving Inspection Readiness (AIR) visits package provides settings with a comprehensive external evaluation of their practice and provision.

The AIR can be useful to prepare settings for other external professionals visits to the setting.

During the visit, consultants will carry out observations with leaders and hold interviews with senior leaders, key staff and parents (agreed prior to the visit).

Following the evaluation, a detailed written report is provided that identifies key priorities and recommendations to support improvement of the quality of provision for children.

Prices start from £468 excluding VAT and travel.

Early Years Quality Standards

The Early Years Quality Standards (EYQS) scheme represents a prestigious recognition that acknowledges and celebrates Early Years schools and settings which demonstrate outstanding commitment to excellence and quality. The scheme is designed to recognise those who consistently strive for the highest standards of early years practice driving a culture of excellence and improving outcomes for all. The EYQS is organised into a two-year cycle. Early Years schools and settings may choose to complete year 1 EYQS as a standalone award or complete both years of the award to achieve EYQS Premium. The award is valid for a period of five years from the date of completion.
