

The Harbour Learning Trust – Case study

Supporting a Trust-Wide MIS Migration Across Multiple Schools

The Challenge: Harbour Learning Trust were looking to purchase a new MIS solution for their schools and reached out to us. They sought a cost-effective solution with ongoing support for staff during the migration process.

The Solution: Our MAT-focused framework, which offers a structured approach to procuring and implementing MIS solutions.

We have in depth experience of helping schools transition their MIS at scale; in 2022 we moved 280 schools over a five-month period, over to Arbor. This framework has helped schools across the country save a total of £489,557 from published prices last year (2023/2024).

Our partnership with the Harbour Learning Trust gave them a streamlined MIS transition, with support before and after the transition and reduced operational costs.

Implementation and Support

The migration journey was meticulously planned and executed, starting 4 weeks before the go-live date and continuing for 4 weeks afterwards. Key elements of the process included:

- **Initial Setup and Planning:** We facilitated an introductory conversation to understand the trust's needs, discussed pricing options, and ensured transparency throughout.
- **Comprehensive Training and Communication:** Schools received tailored training sessions, weekly check-ins with a dedicated consultant, and access to pre-recorded content to help trouble shoot any issues.
- **Go-Live Day:** On the go-live day, our team were available to address any issues. Proactive support ensured that schools knew what to expect and knew exactly who to contact if there were any unforeseen challenges.
- **Ongoing Support:** Our team were available to schools 4 weeks after the go-live day to ensure long-term satisfaction and success with the new MIS.

Outcomes

The migration process concluded successfully, with the final school going live in September 24.

We only finished the last migration in September, but we've already seen massive improvements through increased data visibility and data management that the new MIS offers. We will look to maintain our partnership with HFL Education as a result of the positive experience.
